Andrew A. Papson, 74, Lebanon, passed away Friday, January 9, 2015 at the Good Samaritan Hospital. He was the husband of Lois Downes Papson. He was born in Cambridge, England on November 30, 1940, son of the late Alex M. and Teresa M. Santi Papson. He moved to the United States with his parents and sister on March 1, 1950.

He graduated from Lebanon Catholic High School in 1959. He served with the US Air Force during peacetime. Andrew was a 37 year employee of Met-Ed as a storekeeper and active in the Met-Ed Employee Assoc. and a part time employee as a bartender at the Treadway/Quality Inns for 25 years. He was active in charity work and fund raising for many organizations including the United Way. He was a member of Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church, Cornwall.
