David Samuel Longenecker, 63 of Conestoga passed away at Hershey Medical Center early Saturday morning, July 27, 2024 after months of declining health. Born in Lancaster on October 13, 1960, he was the son of the late Stanley R. Longenecker and Miriam J. Hackman Longenecker. He was the husband of Lori A. Rankin Longenecker with whom he married on April 2, 1994.

Dave was a very proud stone mason. Working in the masonry industry since age 17, he worked for many years for KLB Masonry and then working for himself as Black Hill Masonry. Dave enjoyed fishing, especially at Bowers Beach, Delaware for Stripers. He enjoyed boating, hunting and going to Potter County. He was a Philadelphia Eagles fan but would often be caught watching Steeler games. He was a member of the Pequea Boat Club and former member of Red Rose hunting camp and Green Hill Sportsmen's Association.

Dave was a bit thick headed but provided well for his family until his disability could no longer allow him to do so. Dave deeply missed his son, Chad D. Longenecker who preceded him in death.
