



Frederick F. "Fritz" Carpenter

Frederick F. "Fritz" Carpenter, 82, East Norriton, formerly of Lebanon, passed away Sunday, November 1, 2015 at Jefferson University Hospitals, Philadelphia. He was the husband of the late Almeda J. Gerberich Carpenter who passed away September 30, 2015. Fritz was born in Lebanon on November 16, 1932, son of the late Frank D. and Agnes M. Freshley Carpenter.

Fritz was a 1950 graduate of Lebanon High School and an Army Veteran of the Korean War. He was the retired President of Simon S. Kettering & Sons. Before moving to Montgomery County he had been an active member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church for many years having been a Vice President of church council. He was a mentor for the Lebanon School District, Board Member of Lebanon School District Cedar Foundation, President of LHS Class of 1950 Reunion Committee, member of Friendship Fire Co., Fifth Ward AC, Chaplain of the Lebanon Elks Lodge for 18 years and served as Secretary/Treasurer of South Central Chapter of the Pennsylvania Motor Truck Assoc.

Fritz is survived by daughters Kim E., wife of Robert C. Irwin, King of Prussia, Lori J. Carpenter, wife of Stephen M. Casbeer, Pittsburgh, granddaughters Leslie and Melissa Irwin and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by brothers Kenneth F., Donald F. and Jack F. Carpenter.
