George A. Yorty, 70, Lebanon, passed away Friday, September 28, 2012 at his residence. He was the husband of Judy A. Tice Yorty. He was born in Cornwall on November 22, 1941, a son of the late Lester L. and Matilda Leibig Yorty.

He retired with 20 years of service from the U.S. Air Force and was a Vietnam Veteran. He received Air Force Good Conduct Medal with 4 Oak Leaf Clusters, Air Force Longevity Service Ribbon with 4 Oak Leaf Clusters, National Defense Service Medal Vietnam Service Medal with Bronze Star, Republic of Vietnam Gallantry Cross with Palm and Republic of Vietnam Campaign Ribbon. He later retired from the Harrisburg Post Office with 20 years of service. George was a member of Cornwall United Methodist Church. He was a member of Mt. Lebanon Lodge #226 F&AM, where he was Worshipful Master in 1999. He was also a member of the York Rite Bodies of Lebanon and was past commander of Hermit Commandry in 2003, Tall Cedars of Lebanon Forest 25 and Rajah Shrine, Reading.

George and Judy wintered in Florida, where he enjoyed playing golf. In addition to his wife, George is survived by two sons, Allen N., husband of Tammy Yorty, Robesonia; Jeffrey S., husband of Ann Yorty, Waynesboro; grandchildren, Alyssa and Stuart Yorty, Waynesboro; brother, Donald L. Yorty, Cornwall; sisters, Louise Kahlbaugh, Albany, NY and Nancy McDevitt, Cornwall.
