Harry J. Drain, Jr., 89, of Lebanon, passed away Tuesday, March 10, 2020 at Manor Care Lebanon. He was the husband of Nancy Thomas Drain whom he was married for 62 years. Harry was born in Philadelphia on July 9, 1930, son of Harry J., Sr. and Anna Juhascik Drain.

He was a Marine Corp Veteran of the Korean War. Harry was a retired Nurse Anesthetist at the Lebanon Good Samaritan Hospital. He was a graduate of Pennsylvania School of Nursing and the Pennsylvania Graduate School of Anesthetist.
