Hubert J. "Butch" Stoffer, 61, Lebanon, passed away Sunday, April 10, 2011 at the Hershey Medical Center. He was the husband of Barbara A. Albert Stoffer to whom he was married for 38 years.

He was born in Pang, Rosenheim, Germany on May 10, 1949, the son of Alexander and Elenore Seemann Stoffer.

Butch was a 1967 graduate of Lebanon Catholic High School. He retired from ALCOA as a mill operator in 2002, with 31 years service. Since retiring, he was employed as a groundskeeper at Pine Meadows Golf Course. He was an Army Veteran of the Viet Nam War and retired as a Major from the PA National Guard with 25 years combined service. He had been the commanding officer at the Lebanon Armory.
