He retired in June 1997 as the Engineering Manager for Burle Industries. He and his wife are members of Ascension Lutheran Church. He enjoyed spending time with his family. In his spare time through the years you could find him on the tennis court, behind home plate both as a catcher and umpire, perfecting his golf game and hunting at the South Fairview Rod and Gun Club in Cumberland County where he served as Treasurer for many

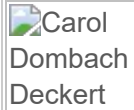
