Jay E. Kreider, 72 of Pequea passed away at Lancaster General Hospital on Tuesday, May 12, 2026. Born on May 11, 1954 in Hershey, he was the son of the late Earl J. and Cora Mae Bowman Kreider. He was the wife of Lucinda F. Lauver Kreider who joined Jay in Heaven three days later on May 15, 2026.

Jay graduated in 1972 from Pequea Valley High School. He played baseball and participated on the rifle and chess teams in high school. He enjoyed going to classic car shows and loved his 1969 Ford Mustang Mach 1 which he was restoring. Jay helped to coach his son from T-ball to age 14 with the Manor Ridge League.
