John Wesley Bell, 84, Hill Farm Estate (Bethel Pointe), North Annville Twp., passed away Thursday, February 16, 2012 at the Lebanon Good Samaritan Hospital. He was born in Lebanon on October 25, 1927, son of the late Clement W. and Miriam Smith Bell.

He was a 1945 graduate of Lebanon High School. He was a Veteran of WWII, having been drafted into the Army after graduation. He was stationed at Ft. McClellan, AL and Ft. Lewis, WA. After being Honorably Discharge as a Corporal in 1947, he began an over thirty year career at the Lebanon Post Office, mostly as a motor route driver. John was especially proud of his safety record and fifty year membership in the National Association of Letter Carriers. He was a member of the American Legion Post 559, Annville and the National Rifle Association. In the past decade he had walked over ten thousand miles.

John is survived by his niece, Susan O'Neill Myer, wife of Norman Myer, Fishers, IN; a great nephew in Ohio; two great nieces and three great-great nephews, all of Indiana. He was preceded in death by sister, Catherine "Kitty" Bell O'Neill.
