Joseph Hannah, Jr., 79, of Lancaster, passed away Saturday afternoon, December 27, 2014 enroute to Hospice & Community Care, Mount Joy. Born in Philadelphia on March 19, 1935, he was the son of the late Joseph, Sr. and Mary Arnold Hannah.

Joe served the United States for 20 years in the United States Navy retiring in 1971 as Chief Petty Officer. He served in both the Korean and Vietnam Wars. He was awarded the Good Conduct Medal several times, Sailor of the Year award, National Defense Service Medal and the European Occupation Medal. After retiring he made his home in Annapolis, always being near the Naval Base. He resided at the Soldiers Home in Washington D.C. before moving to Lancaster to be near his family.

Joe was not a man of many words, usually being the quiet one. Joe loved the Navy Football team, all Philadelphia sport teams, bowling and boating. He was a member of the Fleet Reserve in Annapolis.

Joe was always showing his family generosity, especially the two daughters he leaves behind, Gail S. Johns of Conestoga and Barbara A. wife of Philip Kane of Lancaster and grandchildren, Mercedes Kane, Brittney Davis, Michael Young, and Joseph Johns. He is also survived by his sisters, Mary Wolf of Philadelphia and Betty Dabose of Deptford, NJ. Joe was preceded in death by his granddaughter, Melissa Johns and grandson, Jason D. Young.
