Lou E. Bott, 94, Cornwall, PA, wife of Dr. Anthony R. Bott, passed away Sunday, February 1, 2015 at the Good Samaritan Hospital, Lebanon, PA. Lou was born on August 10, 1920 in Honey Grove, TX, the daughter of the late Carl and Kate (Joyce) Taylor.

Lou met Anthony at Texas A & M University, College Station, TX, where she was employed in the Office of Student Affairs during the time he attended veterinary school there. They married on May 6, 1944 prior to his deployment for service in World War II. While Anthony was in the service, Lou worked for the Eighth Service Command. After the war, she and Anthony made their home in Belleville, IL.

In addition to raising her children, Lou was active in many organizations, including the women's auxiliary of the Illinois State Veterinary Medical Association, serving as its president in 1961, and the Signal Hill United Methodist Church in Belleville, IL. In later years, she performed charitable work at the Good Samaritan Hospital. Lou was an avid golfer and enjoyed countless rounds of golf both with her many friends and her husband Anthony. Lou is survived by her loving husband Anthony; children Nancy wife of Michael Grimes of St. Louis, MO; Anthony "Tony" husband of Yoshiko Bott of Herndon, VA; Cynthia "Cindy" wife of Kirk Fornes, Orange, CT; and grandchildren, Taylor husband of Becca Grimes, Chase Grimes, Tristan Bott. Lou will be greatly missed by all. She was preceded in death by brother Carl Taylor, Dallas, TX.
