Louise Bowman Heagy, 92, died peacefully December 16, 2013 at Cornwall Manor, Cornwall. She was the wife of the late John G. Heagy. She was born November 3, 1921 in Annville, daughter of the late Isaac Leo and Lillie Kreider Bowman.
