



## Percy E. Hartman, Jr.

Percy E. Hartman, Jr., 86, of Lebanon passed away Thursday morning, September 19, 2013 at the Good Samaritan Hospital. Born in Lebanon on June 10, 1927, he was the son of the late Percy E., Sr. and Florence Collins. He was married to Ruth E. Heck, who preceded him in death on September 19, 1982.

Percy served during WWII with the United States Army, where he was honored to drive Gen. George Patton's Jeep. He enjoyed listening to country music and watching old western movies. Percy began working at the Cornwall Railroad in 1948. When the railroad was flooded in 1964, he began to work for Bamberger's Automotive until 1998 as a parts salesman. Percy worked briefly at Lebanon Hardware. He was employed in the dairy department of the Lebanon Wal Mart from 1999 until his illness in June of this year.

Surviving is his daughter, Sandra F., wife of John A. Miller, Jr., Lebanon; grandson, Thomas A., husband of Brooke Miller, Lebanon; granddaughter, Tracie J. Miller, fiancée of Joshua Babetski of Austin, TX and great grandson, Cooper Babetski. He is also survived by brothers, Kenneth and Ralph Hartman, sister, Jean Schwartz, all of Lebanon. He was preceded in death by brothers, Howard, Henry and Frank, along with sisters, Nancy Salisbury, Emma Engle, Annie Hickernell, and Rose Hartman.
