Richard B. Campbell, Sr., 87 of Mountville, formerly of Pittsburg Valley Road, Conestoga passed away Wednesday, May 13, 2020 at Elizabethtown Rehab & Nursing Center. Born in Conestoga on February 17, 1933, he was the son of the late Charles P. and S. Beatrice Kline. He was the husband of Doris M. Ault Campbell who preceded him in death on August 9, 1993.

He was employed with Penn Dot for over 35 years, retiring in 1987. He was one of the last stone masons that Penn Dot employed. He was part of the crew who built the original Route 30 bypass over the Susquehanna River. Earlier in life, he was employed by Rice & Weidman Construction. He was a member of the Elstonville Sportsmen's Associating and enjoyed hunting. He is survived by his son, Richard B.
