Dr. Samuel F. "Pete" Light, Jr., 89, Mt. Gretna, died Monday, July 15, 2013 at Cornwall Manor, Cornwall. He was the husband of the late Gloria Hoffecker Light. He was born in Lebanon on October 7, 1923, son of the late Samuel F. Light, Sr. and Catherine Margaret Garman Light.

Dr. Light was a graduate of Lebanon High School, Bucknell University and University of Pennsylvania. He was a Dentist for many years in the Lebanon area. During WWII he served in the Marine Corp as a sergeant and served in the Navy as a Lieutenant during the Korean Conflict.

He was a member of Mt. Lebanon Lodge #226 F&AM, York Rite Bodies of Lebanon, Harrisburg Consistory, Zembo Temple Harrisburg, Tall Cedars of Lebanon Quittapahilla Forest # 25, Lebanon County Shrine Club, Annville American Legion, American & PA Dental Associations. He was a member and past trustee of Mt. Gretna United Methodist Church. He was a past president of Lebanon Lions Club. He also served 27 years on the Lebanon County Vo-Tech Authority.

He enjoyed his many years living and tending wildlife in the Mt. Gretna woods. He is survived by children, Dr. Robert William Light and wife Judy, Erie; Suzanne L. Cross and husband William, Pennsylvania Furnace; Samuel F. "Pete" Light, III and wife Carol, Mt. Gretna; 5 grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren. His sister, Patricia Attwood preceded him in death.
