Thomas W. Famiglietti, 73, of Lebanon, passed away Sunday, March 29, 2020 at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. Tom was born in The Bronx, NY on September 19, 1945, son of the late Thomas R. and Nelda Moran Famiglietti. He was an Army Veteran of the Vietnam War. He was a steamfitter being a 50 year member Of Steamfitters Union Local 638, NYC. 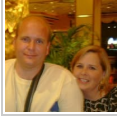
