



William Charles "Buckie" McDaniels, Jr.

William Charles "Buckie" McDaniels, Jr., 100, formerly of Lebanon, passed away on Saturday, February 18, 2017 at the Lebanon Valley Home of the UCC, Annville. He was the husband of the late Phyllis Maxine Drake McDaniels who passed away November 5, 2015, four days short of their 75th wedding anniversary. Buckie was born in Lebanon on July 9, 1916, son of the late William Charles, Sr. and Nancy Lohr McDaniels.

Buckie was retired from the Bethlehem Steel Mines Corp, a division of the Bethlehem Steel as a chemical analyst at the West Lebanon Raw Materials Lab. He was a 1934 graduate of Lebanon High School. He was a member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Lebanon where he had been an active member of the Sunday School and the Lutheran Brotherhood. Buckie was a proud member of the Lebanon Elks Lodge where he recently received a plaque for 75 years of membership and service. He was a member of the Friendship Fire Co, PA Sports Hall of Fame, Bethlehem Steel Bowling League and was an avid Penn State Fan.

Buckie is also survived by numerous

nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his son William Charles McDaniels, III and brothers, Robert, Elmer, Russell and Frank McDaniels.
